Admission Requirements:

1. **For Diploma Holders:** Diploma of engineering from the Bangladesh Technical Education Board (BTEB) or a diploma of engineering recognized by BTEB with a GPA of 2.5 or above, out of 4.0.

2. **For Regular:**

a) GPA of 2.5 in both S.S.C. and H.S.C. or

b) Minimum GPA of 2.0 either in S.S.C. or in H.S.C. with a total of GPA 6.0.

c) For admission into Computer Science course the student must have Physics, Chemistry and Math in both S.S.C and H.S.C

3. **For MSIT:** Candidates must have Bachelor degree in science from a recognized university.

4. **For Foreign Students:** The candidate must hold a valid student visa and obtain the equivalent grades/marks as mentioned above.

Procedure of Evaluation:

A) **Written Test:** A written test for the admission into bachelor degree programs of CSIT/CSE will be held according to the stated schedule. The test will be based on the syllabus of H.S.C. exam and duration of

the written exam is one hour. The exam will be in MCQ and the distribution of marks is as follows:

B) Viva – Voce:

After the written test a viva – voce will be conducted in the same day (04th May 2018) at 11.00 am in the Department.

The candidates must produce the original certificates and marks/grade sheets at the time of viva-voce.

C) Admit Card and Admission Roll No: The candidates must collect their admit cards (student’s copy) from Admission/Information office at the time of submission of their admission forms. They must bring their admit cards at the time of admission test.
